Ischemic stroke patients who got medicine to break up a blood clot within 3 hours after symptoms started.	86%	73%
Ischemic stroke patients who received medicine known to prevent complications caused by blood clots within 2 days of arriving at the hospital.	97%	98%
Ischemic or hemorrhagic stroke patients who received treatment to keep blood clots from forming anywhere in the body within 2 days of arriving at the hospital.	99%	95%
Ischemic stroke patients who received a prescription for medicine known to prevent complications caused by blood clots before discharge.	100%	99%
Ischemic stroke patients with a type of irregular heartbeat who were given a prescription for a blood thinner at discharge.	97%	95%
Ischemic stroke patients needing medicine to lower cholesterol, who were given a prescription for this medicine before discharge.	97%	95%
Ischemic or hemorrhagic stroke patients or caregivers who received written educational materials about stroke care and prevention during the hospital stay.	99%	90%
Ischemic or hemorrhagic stroke patients who were evaluated for rehabilitation services.	100%	98%
