West Jefferson Medical Center's unit based educators have developed a Nurse Residency Program. The program is six months long using a didactic educational model. Each month will include one four hour theory day and one three hour skills day.

Each four hour theory class includes two hours of content lecture, one hour of expert content from a special guest speaker, and one hour of case study and discussion.

Each skills day will include practice and training on all related skills for each topic. All nurses with less than a year of experience will be required to complete the program.
