Psychosocial Distress Screening

Cancer is a complex disease that affects patients in a variety of ways. Patients experience psychological, social, financial and behavioral issues that can interfere with their treatment plans and adversely affect their outcomes. To address the psychosocial issues experienced by patients with cancer, we have a dedicated outpatient social worker who screens all patients for distress. Once distress is identified, the social worker helps patients find resources and/or referrals for psychosocial needs.

Our social worker, in conjunction with our cancer care team, works to continually assess levels of distress and intervenes promptly so you are able to concentrate on what is really important: you and your treatment.
