A different approach to care

We are a group dedicated to the specific needs of those over the age of 65. Your care team has undergone specific training and education to provide advanced care to our aging patients. That means we do things a little bit different.

Engaged and informed support system

We encourage family to visit, and more importantly we encourage family to spend the night. We have recliners available in each room, and a family lounge down the hall for coffee and workspace with Wi-Fi if needed. Your support system is key to your recovery and helping you live a healthy life.

Collaborative daily huddles

Each morning you will see our team “Huddle” come to your room around 11 am. The team consists of physicians, nurses, physical and occupational therapists, pharmacists, social workers, and case managers who all share the goal of getting our patients out of the hospital and back home as soon as it is safe to do so.

This is a fast-moving, multidisciplinary group that meets every morning to share information and keep our patients on track for a timely discharge from the hospital. Our goal is to give you and your family a brief snapshot of the plans for the day as well as what we need to accomplish to leave the hospital safely. We encourage you to be present, take notes, and formulate any questions that you would like to ask the nursing or physician teams during our rounds.

After our team rounds on all patients on our unit, your care team will be available to answer any questions you may have. We ask that patients and family members reserve their questions until after the daily huddles are complete.
