

## **How to “Opt Out” of GNOHIE**

Your healthcare provider belongs to GNOHIE, the Greater New Orleans Health Information Exchange. GNOHIE lets other providers see your health records. This saves time and helps providers give you better care. If you **don’t** want GNOHIE to share your records, you can “opt out” of GNOHIE.

### **What does GNOHIE share?**

- Your health history
- Medicines you take
- Test results, surgery reports, and hospital discharge notes
- Other health information

### **Who will see my information?**

- Your healthcare providers and their staff can see your records to provide treatment.
- GNOHIE may also use your records to improve the way healthcare providers operate and to improve the health of patients in the community.

### **How can I stop GNOHIE from sharing my information?**
